

Tables ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) 2026 for grade conversion

The ECTS method is the tool adopted by the European Union to ensure the correct and transparent transfer between different national assessment systems of students' results in terms of grades. The use of the ECTS scheme is one of the commitments undertaken by the ITS PRIME Tech Academy Foundation in the process of obtaining the European Charter for Higher Education (ECHE), an essential document for accessing European education programme.

According to the ECTS Users' Guide, published in 2015 by the European Commission, the procedures for transferring grades have been modified. The previous ECTS scale, divided into 5 levels (A: highest 10%; B: next 25%; C: next 30%; D: next 25%; E: lowest 10%) has been eliminated and replaced by the calculation of the statistical distribution of grades based on the scale used in the various national systems, drawn up for groups of similar courses, and called the ECTS Table for the conversion of grades. The new table allows for an immediate and transparent comparison between two national assessment systems, ensuring that students receive the correct recognition, in terms of grades, for the results obtained outside their own country.
